This flexible approach offers access to a global talent pool while maintaining control over project direction and management. Only experienced team members are available for this pricing model given the nature of the work:

- an individual needs to blend in a new environment,
- public holidays might differ and flexibility is a must,
- the person might be unable to affect management style and requirements,
- being an external member there might be a conflict between brand loyalty and values.

This model is not a first choice. It takes a while to find a cultural fit. We test this with Agile Team or Prototype plans.

Strengths

Threats

- Cultural differences between permanent and augmented staff can lead to misunderstandings and decreased morale.
- High demand for specialized skills can lead to competition and increased costs for top talent.
- Introducing external members to sensitive projects can increase security and confidentiality risks.
